<b>BEGINNER</b> – A beginner has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher prior to 9/1 of the prior year. Dancer must move to Advanced Beginner the following year				<b>ADVANCED BEGINNER</b> – Hornpipe & Hard Jig at traditional speed. An Advanced Beginner who wins 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , or 3 <sup>rd</sup> place will advance to Novice category in that particular dance in the following year on 1/1. Competitions with less than 5 dancers will be combined with the next age bracket. Competitions could be combined depending on entries.
